GOLF COURSE

After two years experience in the application of Zeogrow achieved in Germany and Slovenia, the results obtained are very interesting and positive in terms of development and the vitality of the lawn. Here we briefly present the results obtained in Slovenia and Germany as well as partly in other countries:





Treatement with Zeogrow is of great benefit for development and long life of plants and lawn of golf courses

1. How to treat with Zeogrow

- Used was a 0.5% solution of Zeogrow in all treated areas, but a small area was always left for control;
- Treatement should be done every 10 days in the initial treatment period (first month) and then every 14 days. Spraying was carried out during the summer, the first spraying is done at the beginning of May;
- It is important that the spraying is not carried out in the rain or in strong wind and sun, it is best to spray in the afternoon or evening.

 Zeogrow-treatment is always carried out a day or two after mowing the lawn or watering

2. Results obtained by spraying Zeogrow golf meadows

- After the first spray the treated lawn takes a dark green color, the gras grows faster and looks tougher;
- The plant cover of the golf field are rooted more luxuriant and the whole lawn is thick and durable;
- Golf courses which are often treated with Zeogrow have a very uniform appearance, the lawn is the same height so it is easier to maintain;
- Zeogrow treated lawns search less watering and are resistant to long dry periods and high temperatures;
- Treated surfaces require less fertilization with mineral fertilizers, and also much less protection than the surfaces that are not treated;
- With multiple treatments during the year the plant has grown a deep root system which makes the lawn look permanently vital, beautiful and more suitable for golf;
- On treated golf lawns it is not necessary to reseeded because the treated area makes a vital and permanent appearance;
- The need for irrigation is significantly reduced, sometimes up to 50% compared to the need for watering of untreated lawn.
